Travel Tips

- **Geography:** Ghana is situated in West Africa and is bordered to the north by Burkina Faso, the east by Togo, the south by the Atlantic Ocean and west by Cote d'Ivoire.
- **Language & Time:** The official language is English and Time is GMT.
- **Electricity:** 220 volts, AC, 50Hz, usually 3 pin plugs.
- **Visas:** Required for all non-Ecowas citizens via Ghana Embassies & High Commission in home country or nearest Ghanaian Consulate.
- **Currency:** Ghana Cedis and Pesewas. GH¢1 =100Gp.
- **Climate:** All year tropical climate. Average annual temperature is 27°C and can go up to 38°C in the north. The coast is subject to refreshing winds.
- **Required clothing:** Tropical lightweight clothing. Sunglasses is advisable.
- **Water:** It is advisable to drink bottled water but tap water in cities is safe to drink.

Natural Conservation

Overview: Ghana has 18 wildlife-protected areas all based on conservation with focus on a few charismatic species example; Mole National Park (The Forest Elephant) and the Wechiau Hippo Sanctuary (The Pygmy Hippos).

The Mole park is home to over 93 mammal species, and the large mammals of the park include an elephant population, hippos, buffalo, and warthogs. Among the 344 listed bird species are the martial eagle the white-headed and palm-nut vultures, saddle-billed storks, herons, egrets, the Abyssinian roller, the violet turaco, various shrikes and the red-throated bee-eater. Mole National Park is by far the Bird Watching Paradise in Ghana. The vast Savannah Woodland accommodates various bird species.

Wechiau Hippopotamus Sanctuary is known to be one of the last strongholds for the pygmy Hippo species in Ghana. The Wechiau Hippo Sanctuary which is a Community Based Tourism initiative came about as a result of the destruction of local fisher folks Fishing Gear by the Hippopotamus in the Black Volta which forms the National Boundaries between Ghana, Burkina Faso & Cote D'Ivoire.

Cultural Conservation

Overview: Some countries in sub-Saharan Africa have areas of significant ecological importance and high levels of natural resource dependence which has seen a change in their local cultural setting.

However in the northern part of Ghana, some ethnic groups such as the Lobi, Wala and Kassena/Nakana People have been able to conserve and pass on their indigenous cultural practices for many centuries. The Lobi belong to an ethnic group that originated in what is today Ghana. Starting around 1770, many Lobi peoples migrated into southern Burkina Faso and later into Côte d'Ivoire.

ECO – TOURISM ACROSS GHANA

AKWASIDAE- FESTIVAL

Join the celebration of the colourful event, taking place every 42 days on the Akan traditional calendar, usually on a Sunday morning. Add another colourful dimension to the Ashanti tour with a visit to the Craft villages. See the skill and imagination of local craftsmen and women using simple tools and traditional technology to produce breath taking artifacts and designs from which you may pick souvenirs for friends and family back home.

- Accra city tour with shopping at the Arts and Crafts Centre.
- A full day tour in the cool serene atmosphere of the Aburi Botanical Gardens.

- Partake in the Akwasidae festival with visits to the craft villages.
- Taste the preparation of our local wine as you go on conducted tours of the slave castles.
- Visit the Kakum National Park for a breath-taking "Walk" on the Canopy Walkway with last minute shopping and departure.
